

2009 – 2010 Pitching Clinics with Planet FastPitch!!

We are ready for another year of fantastic pitching clinics with Planet FastPitch at the Newton YMCA. For returning pitchers, Kaila Holtz has returned home to British Columbia and is happily attending medical school. While we will certainly miss her, we are looking forward to developing a relationship with a new Planet FastPitch instructor.

As in the past, our intent is to group similarly skilled pitchers in the same hour. This is in the best interest of the pitchers and the instructor. Therefore our terms beginner, intermediate, and advanced are relative to who signs up for that particular session. To ensure each pitcher has enough space and instructor-time, each class is limited to 8 pitchers.

Please sign-up with the YMCA for the class you feel is most appropriate as described in the course description. I will check in with the YMCA during the week preceding the first Sunday of each new session. I will notify you if a class change needs to be made as soon as I can, but no later than the Monday following the first Sunday of each 7-week session. If a class change needs to be made and it does not work for you, you will receive a 100% refund.

Session 1: Sunday, September 13 – Sunday, November 8 (no class September 27 & October 11)

TENTATIVE FUTURE SCHEDULE:

Session 2: Sunday, November 15 – Sunday, January 10 (no class November 29 & December 27)

Session 3: Sunday, January 24 - Sunday, March 21 (no class January 17, February 7 & 14)

Session 4: Sunday March 28 - Sunday April 25 (no class April 18). This is a 4 week session.

Other Pitching Clinic Information:

All pitchers must supply their own catcher, preferably an adult.

If there is only enough interest for two sessions they will be held at 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

To reserve a spot (first come - first served) you need to make two payments, one to the YMCA and the second to Newton Girls Softball.

NGSoftball subsidizes the fee paid to Planet FastPitch so we can provide you with outstanding instruction.

"Intermediate" Pitching - 7:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Prerequisite: Attended a minimum of three 7-week pitching sessions at the YMCA last year. As pitchers from this group advance they will be invited to attend the advanced session.

2. Payable to Newton Girls Softball - \$150

"Advanced" Pitching - 8:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

Prerequisite: Attended YMCA advanced pitching sessions last year.
